PASTOR: How was Christ exalted in his ascension?

ALL: **Christ was exalted in his ascension, in that having after his resurrection often appeared unto and conversed with his apostles, speaking to them of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God, and giving them commission to preach the gospel to all nations, forty days after his resurrection, he, in our nature, and as our head, triumphing over enemies, visibly went up into the highest heavens, there to receive gifts for men, to raise up our affections to that place and to prepare a place for us, where he himself is, and shall continue till his second coming at the end of the world.**

Matthew 28:19-20a

PASTOR: "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you."

COPORATE CONFESION OF SIN

ALL: **King Jesus, we confess that we have often been unwilling servants. You have commanded us to bring your gospel to people around us, but we have often dismissed your command. Forgive us for being more concerned with our entertainment than with your kingdom.**

SILENT CONFESION OF SIN

In these moments,

we individually come to God in prayer, silently confessing personal sins so that we may take hold of the forgiveness won for us by Christ, our Redeemer.

ASSURANCE OF PARDON AND PEACE WITH GOD *Col. 1:15-20*

PASTOR: He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him. And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together. And he is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might be preeminent. For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross.


