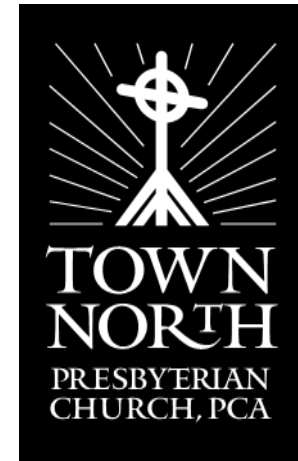

*Westminster Larger Catechism Q&A 79
 (Modern English Version)*

LEADER: Since true believers are imperfect, are tempted, and commit sin, can they fall out of their state of grace?

ALL: **Because of God's unchangeable love, he has decreed and made a covenant with believers that they will persevere, that they are inseparably united to Christ, who continually intercedes for them, and that the Spirit and the seed of God abide in them. Consequently, they can never completely or finally fall out of their state of grace, because the power of God preserves their salvation through faith.**
